2014 FALL LEAF PICKUP SCHEDULE (LEAVES ONLY – ABSOLUTELY NO GRASS – NO DEBRIS, BRANCHES OR PLASTIC BAGS WILL BE ALLOWED OR PICKED UP)

Please rake leaves to the curb (not in the street) at the beginning of the week so you do not miss the pickup date. Be patient, weather may delay pickup. In the event of inclement weather or changes to the schedules indicated below, we will make every attempt to notify the residents accordingly.

The schedule below may be modified at the discretion of the Department of Public Works and areas with heavy accumulations will be addressed accordingly.

- Area 1** Marc Woods South of Union St. (towards Main St.)
Garbage Day – Monday, Recycling Day – Wednesday
- Area 2** Edgemere Dr. & Kimberly, Green & White Village, Crescent Dr., Oak Lane,
Lochslea Hts., Middlesex Rd., Ravine Dr. & Marc Woods from Union St. North
Garbage Day – Tuesday, Recycling Day – Wednesday
- Area 3** West of Rt. 34, including Rt. 34, Contempra & Poet Dr.
Garbage Day – Thursday, Recycling Day – Saturday
- Area 4** East of Rt. 34 – Business District & Atlantic Avenue
Garbage Day – Friday, Recycling Day – Saturday

NOTE: If garbage day or recycling day falls on Thanksgiving, Christmas or New Year's –
Pick-up the following business day – other holidays will be normal schedule.

BULK ITEMS: BRANCHES LESS THAN 3" IN DIAMETER & WOOD MUST BE BUNDLED IN 4' LENGTHS & CAN BE PLACED OUT WITH YOUR GARBAGE. OLD FURNITURE, RUGS & PERMITTED HOUSEHOLD GOODS CAN ALSO BE PUT OUT WITH YOUR GARBAGE. PLEASE BE AWARE ONLY 2 BULK ITEMS ARE PERMITTED PER WEEK.

EXPLANATION OF RECYCLING COLLECTION CATEGORIES

NEWSPAPERS: All inserts acceptable. No magazines, telephone books or junk mail (junk mail to be recycled with mixed paper). Tie with string only. No paper bags, plastic bags or cardboard boxes.

COMMINGLED: Aluminum cans (soda & beer) tin & bi-metal cans used for food products (soup, coffee, tuna, etc.), glass bottles used for food and beverages & plastic containers (#1 & 2 required) soda, laundry, milk and water containers.

Rinse all of the above. Other plastics put in garbage.

EXCLUDED: Plate glass, mirrors, light bulbs, plastic bags and ceramics.

MIXED PAPER: Please note all the items that are recyclable. Junk mail, corrugated cardboard, brown grocery bags, wrapping paper, cereal boxes, cracker boxes, dry soap boxes, shoe boxes, gift boxes, shirt cardboard, file cards, telephone books, magazines, catalogs, envelopes, bond paper, office paper, copier paper, computer paper, greeting cards & books without hard covers. Do not use black bags for paper goods.

NON-ACCEPTABLE MIXED PAPER: Blueprints, carbon paper, napkins, tissues and paper towels. All acceptable mixed paper can be placed in a garbage can or plastic container with a lid labeled "Recycling Container." Cardboard boxes may be used if they are sturdy. **DO NOT PUT NEWSPAPERS OUT WITH YOUR MIXED PAPER.**

ITEMS BANNED FROM LANDFILL IN ADDITION TO SCHEDULED ITEMS

Permanent Hazardous Waste drop off site is located at 3211 Shafto Road, Tinton Falls, Monmouth County Residents only. To make a necessary appointment call 732-683-8686 ext. 5210

REFRIGERATORS, AIR CONDITIONERS AND DEHUMIDIFIERS: When you purchase a unit, have the vendor take the old unit. If not possible, put at curb with garbage. Counts as bulk item.

LARGE METAL APPLIANCES: Dishwashers, clothes washer & dryers, hot water heaters, stove. When you purchase

a unit have the vendor take the old unit. **MOST IMPORTANT:** If not possible, put at curb with garbage. Counts as bulk item.

ASBESTOS SHINGLES & SIDING: This is extremely hazardous material. Do not put out with garbage. Call solid waste enforcement at 732-683-8686 ext. 5658 or 5141.

BATTERIES – HOUSEHOLD: Put in regular trash.

AUTOMOTIVE BATTERIES: Have vendor keep old one. If not possible, call hazardous waste, 732-683-8686 ext. 5210

for appointment – same for old tires.

MOTOR OIL: Full service stations, Jiffy Lube and hazardous waste facility accept motor oil (fee may apply).

GRASS CLIPPINGS: "Cut & Leave It" – or backyard compost are the best method of disposal. If not possible, take to recycling area at the landfill in Tinton Falls and you will be charged \$3 per carload, \$1.75 per pound, 100 pounds by truckload. Call Monmouth County at 732-683-8686 ext. 5141 for hours of operation.

PAINT CANS: Remove lids and put empty cans in garbage. **Latex Paints:** small amounts – remove lid, allow to dry & put empty can in garbage. If more than 1 inch of paint, combine with kitty litter or latex solidifier and put in trash – oil based paints: take to hazardous waste site – **SEE ABOVE.**

BUSINESSES: Must recycle bottles, cans, high grade paper & corrugated cardboard in addition to all items listed above.
