A Blizzard Warning is in effect for our area from 12:00 pm Monday until 6:00 pm Tuesday. Snow accumulations of 18-28 inches are possible with locally higher amounts. Winds will be 20-30 mph with gusts of 45 mph. Travel during this time period will be very hazardous or impossible as a result.

Please be reminded that current Local Ordinance prohibits the parking of vehicles on any street within the Borough whenever snow covered. This prohibition remains in effect until the snow has stopped and the streets have been plowed sufficiently. Residents should wait for the Department of Public Works to completely clear the roadway, curb to curb, before clearing snow from their sidewalks and driveways.

Due to the anticipated snow accumulations, garbage pick-up scheduled for Tuesday, January 27th has been cancelled. Please do not bring your trash to the curb. A rescheduled pick-up date will be forthcoming.
