## **Poster Contest Rules**

Use this checklist to make certain all entries are eligible for judging. Entries not meeting these guidelines will be disqualified.

- 1. Submit entries by Monday, April 18, 2022 to: Earth Day Poster Contest Borough of Matawan Clean Communities Coordinator, 201 Broad Street, Matawan, NJ 07747.
- 2. All entries must be original artwork created by a student who is currently in kindergarten, first thru third grade. A student may enter the contest only once.
- 3. The student's first and last name and grade level must be printed in the lower right-hand corner on the back of the poster.
- 4. a) Entries may be done in marker, crayon, paint pens, watercolor, ink, acrylic, colored pencil, and/or tempura paint. b) Collages are not acceptable. (Do not glue anything on your poster.) c) Computer or photo generated art and/or printing is not acceptable.
- 5. Entries must be on  $12 \times 18$  poster paper. The poster must be related to the contest theme in some way. The theme "How to Keep Our Community Clean" must be on the poster. All judges' decisions are final.
- 6. Don't forget to check the spelling of words on your poster.
