

Dear Residents:

The Borough's trash and recycling hauler Central Jersey Waste will no longer pick up branches effective immediately. Trash containing grass or yard debris (leaves, branches, etc.) will not be picked up unless these items are removed. Recycling of these items will make the most of your hard earned tax dollars.

The following changes will become effective Tuesday, July 19, 2016 to accommodate the large volume of branches and yard debris in town. The Department of Public Works employees will pick up the following every other Tuesday (put on curb not in street the day before):

- **Tree Limbs/Branches - Maximum length three feet. Maximum diameter 3 inches. Tied in bundles not weighing more than 25 pounds. Place neatly behind the curb, not in the street.**
- **Other Vegetative Waste (leaves, sticky balls, vines, trimmings from shrubs or plants) – must be placed in brown recyclable bags that can be obtained by calling 732-290-2015, or picked up in person at the municipal bldg. at 201 Broad Street (limit 10 per address) currently at no cost, residents requiring bags in excess of 10 will be charged at the rate of 2 for \$1.00 , NO YARD DEBRIS IN PLASTIC BAGS OR CANS WILL BE PICKED UP. Place behind the curb not in the street. Residents may call DPW when the bags are ready for removal, or drop off at DPW brush dumpster @ 1 Public Works Drive (M-F from 7:30 am – 2:30 pm).**
- **Absolutely no grass – resident must cut and leave on the lawn, compost or can take to the reclamation center in Tinton Falls for a fee.**
- **Shrubs – Individual shrubs not weighing more than 25 pounds with all soil removed can be placed behind the curb line or brought directly to DPW brush dumpster. Call for pickup.**
- **Stumps - Stumps will not be collected. Residents must make other arrangements.**
- **Landscapers performing re-landscaping or cleanup projects are responsible to remove all debris.**

From OCTOBER thru DECEMBER – Brush and Yard Debris will not be picked up but can still be brought to the DPW Works brush dumpster @ 1 Public Works Drive. DPW employees will be focusing all their efforts on Fall leaf pickup and snow removal at that time.
