

This is a message from the Matawan Office of Emergency Management:

A Blizzard Warning is in effect for our area from midnight tonight until 10:00 am Sunday. Heavy snow and high winds are anticipated.

Please be reminded that current Local Ordinance prohibits the parking of vehicles on any street within the Borough whenever snow covered. This prohibition remains in effect until the snow has stopped and the streets have been plowed sufficiently. Residents should wait for the Department of Public Works to completely clear the roadway, curb to curb, before clearing snow from their sidewalks and driveways. Also, please be reminded to clear the snow from your nearest fire hydrant.

Due to the anticipated snow accumulations, mixed paper recycling pick-up scheduled for Saturday, January 23rd has been cancelled. Please do not bring your recycling to the curb. Both mixed paper and newspaper recycling will be picked up on Wednesday, January 27th.
