Purpose(s): Matawan Main Street Streetscape Improvement Program – Phase II, Including the Purchase and Installation of ADA Compliant Sidewalks, Curb Cuts, and Crosswalks and All Work and Materials Necessary Therefor or Incidental Thereof.

Bonds/Notes Authorized: \$108,000 Grants Appropriated: \$152,321 Section 20 Expenses: \$27,000

Useful Life: 10 years
