

- ➤ Having businesses work together more with one another.

- ➤ There was feedback about the ease of opening a business in Matawan. The Commission would like to look at this process with the Borough as well as the Chamber and see if there are any opportunities to streamline it. The possibility of putting together a new business packet or folder was mentioned.
