- Need more volunteers in general
- Entertainment mats worked out great; DJ was great; could have used more entertainers.
- Interviews Emcees were great; maybe interviews can be held at sponsor tables instead of the video booth.
- Meeting next week with police, DPW, fire, etc to go over changes for next year
