### III. Osprey Platform

- a. Joe Reynolds from NY/NJ Baykeeper (and his non-profit *Save Coastal Wildlife*) joined the meeting to discuss the installation of an osprey platform in Matawan
- b. Possible location: between Ravine Drive and Aberdeen Road along the creek. Would be able to see from the future Burrowes-Forman Path
- c. One caveat to be aware of: platform cannot be installed near trees, as the greatest predators of ospreys are great horned owls, which is why ospreys prefer to nest in the open
- d. Joe going to investigate the area to see if and where viable options would be, as well as access points for installing the platform
- e. Platforms go up during low tide, early in the morning and on a weekend. Takes about 60-90 minutes
- f. Early March is the preferred installation window to be ahead of osprey activity, then hopefully the platform will be active on 1-2 years, otherwise in may take up to 5 to 6 years for it to become active.
