Jerry indicated that the request on Spring Street was handled by boro DPW since tree was on boro property. Jerry spoke to Bob Fisher and told him the borough will not cut down the trees hanging over his property due to budget cuts and that the trees are alive. At present time community service is not active.

Grace indicated that she will continue to update our web site and she will meet with boro engineer about runoff issue in boro. Classes at Rutgers will begin again soon.
