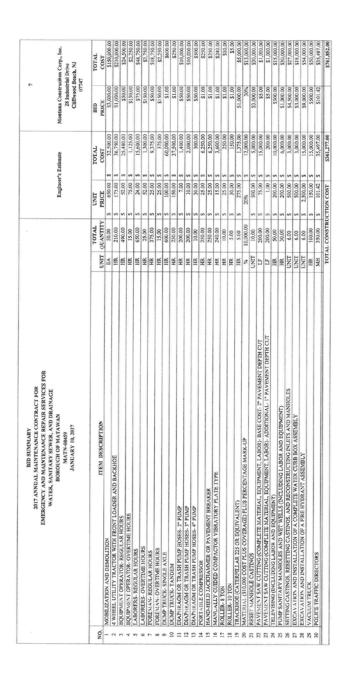

However, we noted that on Page 6 of 10 (Bidder's Certification), the form requires that as a corporation the President and at least one other officer must sign the form in question. The form in TLC's bid package was signed by two individuals with the title "Member". We requested clarification from the bidder and were advised that the signee's were officers of the firm and their "official titles" in the firm are listed as "Member".

Additionally, we contacted several of TLC's references and confirmed that they have satisfactorily completed similar projects. Therefore, it is my recommendation that the project be awarded to TLC Drain & Sewer for the base bid in the amount of \$66,514.80 subject to availability of funds and approval of the Borough Attorney. The award should also be made subject to the approval of the N.J. Department of Labor, and the Office of Wage and Hour Compliance.

ORDINANCE 17-01
ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE CODE OF
THE BOROUGH OF MATAWAN
CHAPTER II – ADMINISTRATION
ARTICLE IV – ADMINISTRATIVE ORGANIZATION OF THE
DEPARTMENTS OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT
SECTION 2-14.1 – POLICE DEPARTMENT COMPOSITION

WHEREAS, within its general powers as a municipality, the Borough of Matawan may make and enforce ordinances, rules and regulations not contrary to Federal or State law as it deems necessary and to protect the public safety and welfare of its residents; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Matawan support and encourage efficiency within the Matawan Police Department; and

WHEREAS, based upon the recommendation of the Chief of Police and the Public Safety Committee the current supervisory and staffing level of the Department should be revised to address the needs of the municipality and to address appropriate levels of protection of the general public.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Matawan that Chapter II – Administration, Article IV – Administrative Organization of the Departments of Local Government, Section 2-14.1 – Department Establish; Composition hereby amended as follows:

2-14.1 Department Established: Composition

The Police Department of the Borough of Matawan is hereby established and shall consist of a Chief of Police, two (2) Lieutenants, five (5) Sergeants, up to fifteen (15) Patrol Officers, such Class I and Class II Special Law Enforcement Officers as authorized by state statute (NJSA 40A-146.14-17), three (3) Police Matrons, such School Crossing Guards as recommended by the Chief of Police, one (1) Records Clerk/clerical assistant and such other employees as may be appointed by the governing body upon recommendation by the Chief of Police.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, if any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subdivision clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, this ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication as provided by law.

Privilege of the Floor

Mayor Altomonte opened the Privilege of the Floor.

Councilman Caldon introduced Matthew Schoffel of the Shade Tree Commission to update Council on the Commission and their objectives.

Matthew Schoffel, 4 Cedar Street, Matawan. Mr. Schoffel informed some of the objectives include a resident sponsored tree planting program, and tree trimming at Lake Lefferts. Councilman Caldon stated currently the Commission reacts to falling trees rather than the maintenance and addition of trees in the Borough. Mr. Schoffel believes the lakeside tree trimming can be done in conjunction with the Recreation Department to prepare the lake for the spring/summer season. Councilman Reeve mentioned previous conversations with Mr. Ferrara about the weeds growing by the dam, and having them cut down last year, suggesting this be done on an annual basis. Mr. Ferrara stated, unfortunately, the Shade Tree budget is relatively small, approximately \$10,000.00, with the average cost of tree removal approximately \$3,000.00 and up.

Loretta Windas, 138 Aberdeen Road, Matawan. Ms. Windas suggested the Animal Advisory Board could kick off 2017 by acknowledging 'World Spay Day', on February 28th. She informed of some low-cost spay/neuter services offered by the SPCA in Eatontown, The Spay/Neuter Center in

Holmdel, and also People for Animals, in Hillside. Ms. Windas suggested a press release from the Mayor or Council. She offered to write the release and give it to her contact at the *Independent*; perhaps some publicity on a local radio station. Mayor Altomonte agreed with this idea, and said he will speak to Mr. Menna about putting something on the Borough website. He asked Ms. Windas to write a statement for him. Mr. Menna offered Ms. Windas send the statement to the Clerk for a Resolution to be prepared at a future Council meeting.

Bob Ericksen, representing Harvest Time Worship Center, located at 63 Cliffwood Avenue, Aberdeen. Mr. Ericksen informed he came to the meeting to offer the Church's assistance for the local communities. Mayor and Council thanked Mr. Ericksen.

Mayor Altomonte closed the Privilege of the Floor.

Mr. Menna announced the Mayor and Council will be going into Executive Session, where no formal action will be taken, for the purpose of contract negotiations. Council will not return to formal session.
